

## ICPP-9 Call for Nominations SPP/JPP Young Investigator Awards for 2016

Deadline: November 1, 2015

The **SPP/JPP Young Investigator Awards** were established at ICPP-1 in Dijon to recognize outstanding young scientists in the field of porphyrins, phthalocyanines or related macrocycles. It is anticipated that up to three Young Investigator Awards will be presented at **ICPP-9**, which will be held in *Nanjing, China, July 3-8, 2016*. The winners will present an award lecture and will receive free meeting registration, a plaque of recognition and \$1000 to help cover expenses for participation in the Conference.

All individuals under the age of 40 at the time of the meeting are eligible for the award, which will be evaluated on the basis of the following items:

- a) Nomination letter (maximum 3 pages)
- b) Summary of applicant's current research activities (maximum 2 pages)
- c) Curriculum vitae, which includes the name of the applicant's Ph.D. and postdoctoral advisor(s), all appointments held and all publications.
- d) Two letters of recommendation from people familiar with the work of the candidate.

Each applicant should arrange to have the nomination packet and letters of recommendation sent by e-mail directly to the SPP Office in Dijon (at spp@u-bourgogne.fr) as PDF files.
