# SPP/JPP Young Investigator Awards for 2014

Deadline: October 1, 2013

The **SPP/JPP Young Investigator Awards** were established at ICPP-1 in Dijon to recognize outstanding young scientists in the field of porphyrins, phthalocyanines or related macrocycles. It is anticipated that up to three Young Investigator Awards will be presented at **ICPP-8**, which will be held in **Istanbul, Turkey, June 22-27, 2014**. The winners will present an award lecture and will receive free meeting registration, a plaque of recognition and \$1000 to help cover expenses for participation in the Conference.

**All individuals under the age of 40 at the time of the meeting are eligible for the award, which will be evaluated on the basis of the following items:**

- Nomination letter (maximum 3 pages)*
- Summary of applicant's current research activities (maximum 2 pages)*
- Curriculum vitae, which includes the name of the applicant's Ph.D. and postdoctoral advisor(s), all appointments held and all publications.*
- Two letters of recommendation from people familiar with the work of the candidate.*

Each applicant should arrange to have the nomination packet and letters of recommendation sent directly to the **SPP Office in Dijon**. These should be mailed as hard copy and also sent by e-mail as PDF files.
